
Victory Voices: Aiding Student Success

Pocast Studio Concept

This graphic was inspired by the recording studio microphone combined with the speach bubble shape to represent the student voices and conversation. Raven and Shield Concept

This graphic uses inpiration from Sam Houston himself as a starting point, by referencing his Cherokee name of "Raven". High contast colors incorporating the official school orange combined with energetic lines convey a sense of timely good news and important content.
